

Dear Parents,

Following are short descriptions of what your child will be studying by grade level as they progress through our Religious School. I hope this will help you understand not only what they will be learning in the current year, but also what they have to look forward to as they continue their religious education.

Our TAPT (Toddlers and Parents Too) program is designed for two- and three-year-olds. Children and their parent(s) meet every Sunday morning from 9:00–10:30am where they learn about Judaism with songs, art projects, special snacks, and child-centered activities.

Grades pre-K through two attend school on Sunday mornings from 9:00am–12:00pm. These classes learn about Jewish holidays, Hebrew letters, Bible stories, and Torah from wonderfully creative teachers who have had years of experience with children of these ages. A special program, Torah Together, brings students and parents together to learn and participate in fun activities. The student/parent portion of the morning is followed by a related adult study with Cantor Vera.

Grades three through seven also meet on Sunday mornings from 9:00am–12:00pm, as well as on Wednesday afternoons from 4:00–6:00pm. These students begin a more intensive study of the Hebrew language, learning to read and write Hebrew. Their textbooks are based on Hebrew prayers for various daily, holiday, and Shabbat services. By seventh grade, they will be ready to prepare for becoming a bar or bat mitzvah.

Grades three through seven have additional Judaica curriculum focusing on Israel, holidays (in greater depth), Jewish history, attitudes toward God and why things happen as they do, the prophets, and being a “mensch.” Field trips may be scheduled for these grades; they may visit Mayyim Hayyim (mikvah), participate in a Jewish scavenger hunt in Brookline, or take a trip to a Jewish cemetery, to name a few.

Our High School program for students in grades eight through twelve is held on Monday evenings from 6:00–8:00pm. We begin with some time for socializing and sharing pizza and ice cream, and then proceed to class. Eighth grade students study comparative religion, ninth graders prepare for their confirmations, and our tenth through twelfth graders discuss current topics related to Judaism, ethics and values, and social action as they prepare for Jewish life after high school.

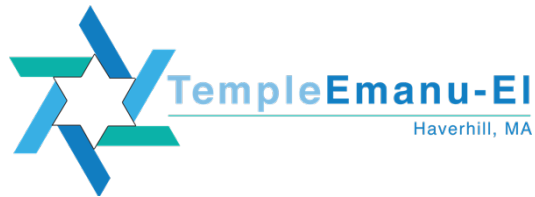

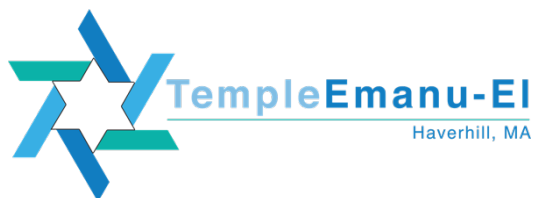
